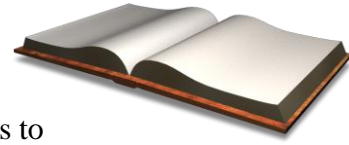


# Knowing the Bible 101 for Children - Part II

A significant part of this Journey with Knowing the Bible 101 for Children will be scripture memorization. We encourage all students to memorize as many scriptures as possible as well as the 66 books of the Bible. At the **Bible Celebration on November 22<sup>nd</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>**, students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their skill in memorizing scriptures and the books of the Bible. Awards will be given to those you show their Mastery of the Memory at this time.

Attached are the seven scriptures we will be using during this rotation. You can select any of these scriptures to memorize or select a favorite one of your own.

**Parents**, assisting your child at home with this task will be most helpful. We encourage home memory practice. Take time with your child to choose a scripture to memorize.
