

## Wordless Book and Flipper Flapper

### **GOLD:**

Think of money, riches  
The richest one in the universe – God  
We know from the Bible  
Gold means pure. God is pure.  
People get married and give gold rings because they love each other.  
God loves you! –John 3:16 – “God so loved the world that He gave his only begotten Son that who ever believes in Him will not die but have ever lasting life.

### **There’s a problem:**

#### **DARK:**

Dark Heart means that people want their own way – sin.  
Doing, saying or thinking bad things  
Romans 3:23 – “All have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God.”  
We are separated from God.  
Sin must be punished

### **God made a way:**

#### **RED:**

Listen and see if you can tell why the red  
God came as a baby to earth  
Grew to be a man but had no sin  
God’s plan was to punish Jesus (himself/son) for our sins  
Jesus Christ willingly bled and died on the cross to take away our sins.  
What does red stand for?  
1 Peter 3:18 – “Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust (the good for the bad) that he might bring us to God.”  
God was pleased and brought Jesus back to life and he is in heaven with God.

### **Good News:**

#### **CLEAN:**

What Jesus did – dying for our sins – lets us have a clean heart and be close to God.  
Another gift – ever lasting life. John 3:1  
and another gift – forgiveness of sins --Acts 3:19 - “Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord,…”  
Who can have these gifts? Anyone who believes in Jesus, trusting Him, willing for God to help you stop doing wrong things and trust Him for forgiveness.  
Are you ready to do that? Why would you want to do that?

### **One more color:**

#### **GREEN:**

What does Green make you think of?  
Growing, plants, trees, grass  
God wants you to grow as a Christian  
You have been born into God’s family  
We have to learn to trust God to help us grow.  
1 John 1:9 – “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness”.  
God promises, “I will never leave you” – Hebrews 13:5

Pray with child and encourage them to:

1. Talk to God – pray (1 Thess. 5:17)
2. Listen to God – learn God’s Word (Ps. 119:11)
3. Talk for God – witness or tell others (Mark 16:15)
4. Worship God – go to church (Hebrews 10:25)
